(R) Underground Paid Parking

First two hours - no charge - register licence plate

7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday-Friday \$2 per hour

After 5 p.m. on weekdays, and all day weekends and holidays \$2 flat fee

- Please follow all posted signs (e.g., 24-hour reserved stalls, permit required times)
- Accessible parking available
- No charge to drive down to the elevators to drop off or pick up a person with disabilities
- No charge to drive down to P1 to use the library book return bin in the Community Centre Parkade

#### Hours of operation

Monday-Friday: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Sunday: 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Note: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. P-East only — Centre in the Park Parkade P1 only — Community Centre Parkade

# **Centre in the Park**

Centre in the Park is a sustainable urban design development in Sherwood Park, Alberta.

The district has over 1,300 parking stalls managed through an integrated parking system. It is designed with traffic calming measures to accommodate pedestrians, cyclists and drivers.

Paid parking and parking time limits help create parking stall turnover to improve parking availability and manage parking demands.

# Two underground parkades to serve the area

- Community Centre Parkade
- Centre in the Park Parkade
  - Heated, underground paid public parking



### Register your licence plate

To receive two-hours parking at no charge (and to avoid a parking ticket), once you've parked your vehicle in the parkade, you must register your licence plate number at a parking pay station even if you are parking for two hours or less.

If you plan to stay for more than two hours, you must purchase the additional parking time at the paid parking rates that apply.

- To register, have your vehicle's licence plate number
- Follow pay station instruction prompts
  - First two hours will indicate no charge
- Pay by credit card OR exact coins
- No need to display receipt on dash

You can also go back to any of the parking pay stations to purchase more time.
